

Dr. Halfdanarson is an Associate Professor of Medicine and a consultant in medical oncology at the Mayo Clinic in Minnesota. He earned his medical degree from the University of Iceland and completed an internal medicine residency at the University of Iowa. He subsequently completed a fellowship in Hematology and Medical Oncology at Mayo Clinic, Minnesota. Dr. Halfdanarson was on faculty as a medical oncologist and neuroendocrine specialist at the University of Iowa after completing his fellowship in 2007 until he transferred to the Mayo Clinic in Arizona where he was for 3 years. He has been on faculty at the Mayo Clinic in Minnesota since 2015.
