

William C. Dooley, M.D., Professor, received his medical training at Vanderbilt and his surgical and surgical oncology training at Johns Hopkins Hospital in Baltimore, Maryland and Oxford University in England. He was on the Johns Hopkins faculty from 1987 to 2000 and served as the Director of the Johns Hopkins Breast Center since 1993. In January 2001 he joined the University of Oklahoma Department of Surgery as the G. Rainey Williams Professor Chair in Surgical Breast Oncology, OU Breast Institute (OUBI). June 2011, the OUBI received national certification from the National Accreditation Program for Breast Centers (NAPBC), the first certified breast cancer treatment facility in the state. The program was touted as the model for all academic breast centers because of aggressive and assertive quality initiatives under Dr. Dooley's leadership. In 2013 he was elected to the Commission on Cancer of the American College of Surgeons and American Cancer Society and awarded the State chair award for the largest impact on cancer control in his home state.
