

Dr. Humphrey grew up in Dallas, TX and completed her B.A. in Biology, magnum cum laude, at Austin College. She completed her MD, PhD in the Medical Science Training Program (MSTP) at Baylor College of Medicine. Dr. Humphrey subsequently completed Internal Medicine internship, residency, and Chief residency as well as Rheumatology fellowship at the University of California San Francisco.
