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Professional Practice Gap: Four in 10 adults and 7 in 10 cancer patients engage in complementary and integrative medicine. Yet most healthcare professionals are not aware of the existing evidence-base to support the use of integrative medicine and lifestyle factors to improve cancer outcomes.
