Professional Practice Gap: Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome (ARDS) is a common cause of respiratory failure associated with high rates of morbidity and mortality. As such, early recognition of and swift intervention upon the patient with ARDS are imperative. As our understanding of the underlying mechanisms which contribute to ARDS progress, we must continue to evaluate our management strategies in order to optimize outcomes in these high-risk, critically-ill patients.
