Professional Practice Gaps:

Gap 1: Clinicians frequently lack factual knowledge of the costs and outcomes of US health care when asked by patients or others. Gap 2: Clinicians frequently lack a facts based opinion on needed changes to the US health care financing system and the difficulties to effect change. This often occurs in a setting where the physician is being asked as a presumed expert.
